### **Pastor's Corner**



Even though Costco and many other retailers have already begun selling Christmas decor and presents, Thanksgiving is still around the corner and November is still with us. It can be frustrating to see our psyches being pushed so quickly through the seasons by the world around us. Too often we begin to worry about things that are still literally two months away! This can especially be the case for churches as we try to help one another be present in God's grace each day, not just on special celebrations.

As a pastor, Ralph and I plan months out for activities and significant public services like Christmas and Easter, but our weekly worship worries seem to reset each Sunday afternoon and begin anew on Mondays even when we prepare ahead. It's one of the ways that I try to remain present to the worship each Sunday instead of trying to rekindle an inspiration from months before. But, alas, our culture needs us to have as much time as possible to convince us to buy the things we don't need and so we now can find Christmas gifts in the aisles in late September. (Please forgive the rant that I am using as a metaphor.)

As a month, November contains three significant celebrations for us to remember this year: All Saints Sunday (Nov 5th), Veteran's Day (Nov 11th), and Thanksgiving (Nov 23rd). Each of these celebrations are times of gratefulness and thanksgiving for God's blessings in our lives. Celebrating the lives and legacies of the Church Triumphant that has transformed our lives through their life, witness, and ministry takes place on All Saints Sunday. We recall and are thankful for those who served in our military to protect us and to fight for justice around the world on Veteran's Day.

Stay present...stay grateful. Amen.




#### **Youth Gathering**

#### We Have Trees on Our Campus!

You're probably not sure when was the last time you noticed that we have a lot of trees on our campus. Lately you've paid more attention to the shade that they provide. When our tree service, Trees 'N Things, prepares a plan for trimming and shaping, they include the type of tree and the quantity. Our campus of 5.5 acres has 64 trees, and here's how they are listed....

Ficus, 2; Carrotwood, 1; Modesto Ash, 1; Orchid, 1; Mimosa, 2; Liquidambar, 7; Pine, 15; Jacaranda, 2; Pear, 2; Melaleuca, 6; Red Iron Bark Eucalyptus, 2; Camphor, 3; Canary Island Pine, 7; Chinese Elm, 9; Tulip, 3; and Floss Silk, 1. For the most part, I am unable to identify the various trees, and it's a real treat to follow along behind Nicolas (from Trees 'N Things) while he does the identifications.

The WMD crew and Jorge spend quite a bit of time each week making sure the irrigation system is working properly. We are truly blessed to have such a verdant campus. Just thought you'd like to know how you're getting your shade.

### San Fernando Valley Rescue Mission

**Home Again and Renewed Hope Update** 



NUMC Missions appreciates the many years of leadership from Lulu Emery in coordinating the dinner staffing for SFVRM Home Again and Renewed Hope. The Home Again program is now back to full occupancy with about 80 women, men and children. The Renewed Hope program continues for about 20 men.

Unfortunately, we do not have enough funding to continue serving two meals per month. Starting in September we are back to serving a meal on the first Tuesday of each month. We need one/two volunteers each month to plan the meal and purchase the food items for preparation in the SFVRM kitchen. Additional volunteers (usually four) are needed to help with food preparation and serving. The preparation normally starts at 5 PM with serving beginning at 6 pm. The team is normally done before 7 PM.

Nancy Kaplan and Mike Easterly have volunteered to co-coordinate the scheduling of volunteers starting in November. We will be asking for meal planners to sign up for each month of 2024. We will also be building a list of volunteers for helpers who can be contacted the week prior to the dinner to complete each month's team. Watch for the sign-up sheets starting in November.

We also need donations to continue providing financial support for these meals. Costs normally run between \$100 - \$150.

### Dr. Garineh Avakian- voice Dr. Joseph Lee- piano



Garineh Avakian is originally from Los Angeles, California. She graduated with a doctorate of musical arts in vocal performance from the USC Thornton School of Music. She holds a bachelor and master in music from the San Francisco Conservatory of Music, also a Graduate Certificate Diploma from the USC Thornton School of Music. She has minored in both piano and conducting during her graduate studies. Currently Dr. Avakian is a tenured associate professor of voice and choral music at Pierce College in the Los Angeles Community College District. She has been on voice faculty and has taught advanced music theory/musicianship, piano, and voice at the American Musical and Dramatic Academy College and Conservatory for the Performing Arts in Hollywood.

Dr. Avakian is a member of Pi Kappa Lambda National Music Honor Society, she serves on the Southern California Vocal Association board and is a member of the American Choral Directors Association. She is also a proud member/chorister of the Los Angeles Master Chorale since 2015. Dr. Avakian has been on faculty as a full-time visiting assistant professor in vocal arts and commercial piano at the University of Texas at El Paso. She currently is the Director of Music at Northridge United Methodist Church where she conducts the Chancel Choir. She regularly performs as a soloist with various organizations in the greater Los Angeles area and has a private voice studio as well.



Joseph Hojun Lee is a versatile musician. As a solo / collaborative organist and keyboardist, he has performed at Carnegie Hall, Schoenberg Hall, Crystal Cathedral, First Congregational Church, Westwood Presbyterian Church, Beverly Hills Episcopal Church, Walt Disney Concert Hall in USA, Sejong Center, Seoul Art Theatre, Seoul Arts Pool Center, London Cathedral, Southwalk Cathedral in England, Swansee Cathedral, St., David's Cathedral in Weils.

Mr. Lee is a composer and arranger, who encompasses a wide range of compositions: from solo to Orchestra and Art song, Chorus to Opera. His works have been performed in America, Canada, Europe, and Egypt. Recently, his choral works has been performed by Los Angeles Master Chorale and Seraphic Fire. His works have been published through Hal Leonard, Fred Bock, Colla Voce.

Currently, he is organist at Northridge United Methodist Church, and faculty at Califirnia Art University.
