# **QC Transit Service Overview**

#### Trains

Each train line has a color name. Each line runs daily, every 7-13 minutes and every 10-15 minutes in the evening and weekends. See the QC Service  $\,$ Times chart on the reverse side for exact details. There are free connections between all trains, as well as CATS and CCTS buses. Accessible stations are marked with &.

A QC Assistant or Security Guard is available to assist you at any operating station. Customer Assistance call buttons are locate near turnstiles, fare vending machines, and on platforms. Obtain a QC Transit map, timetable, or Charlotte City Guide from rail station brochure racks. Train times are posted. Weekend schedules apply on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

Signs on stations indicate train routes and destinations. Trains are marked with front and side signs indicating rail line color and destination. System maps are posted in all rail cars. Stops and connections are announced.

### **CATS Buses**

Most routes run daily through late evening, every 10-20 minutes. All routes have timetables. Weekend schedules apply on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

Always check the destination signs. Not all buses travel to the end of the line. Also, a few routes have branches. All CATS buses are able to squat, and most are wheelchair accessible. Just ask the driver for assistance.

#### **Charlotte Uptown Trolley**

Trolleys run daily, every 20-30 minutes, with trolleys leaving more often during rush hours. Trolleys run late on Charlotte Arena and Tremont Music Hall event nights. QCards are accepted; fare may also be paid to the operator. All trolleys are wheelchair accessible .


# Loop Lines


Trains on the Orange (Interior Loop) and Brown (Exterior Loop) lines run in both directions 24 hours a day. Trains traveling on the Outer Rail run on a clockwise loop, while Inner Rail trains run on a counter-clockwise loop.

Look for signs in loop stations and on platforms to determine train direction. A QC Assistant is on duty at all times to help you reach your destination.


