



MELBOURNE INTERNATIONAL COFFEE EXPO

Set over four days at the Melbourne Showgrounds, MICE is Australia's largest trade-show dedicated solely to coffee.

In addition to showcasing the most high profile coffee competitions in the world, the expo allows industry heavyweights to connect and share ideas. Satellite events in and around Melbourne include roasting workshops, cafe tours, opportunities to meet the personalities behind your favorite grind, and of course the chance to drink the perfect cup. With over 150 exhibitors in 2013, the expo welcomes cafe owners,

WORLD BARISTA CHAMPIONSHIPS

The World Barista Championships is the largest international coffee competition in the world. Produced annually by World Coffee Events and hosted by a different international city each year, from Monte Carlo to Copenhagen, this year is Melbourne's chance to showcase the winner as part of the Melbourne International Coffee Expo. Each year baristas from over 55 countries compete against each other,

making a set list of coffees in fifteen minutes. The championship serves to give baristas a platform to show off their skills to a worldwide audience. This year sees Australian Matt Perger of St Ali competing for the title. www.worldbaristachampionship.com

WORLD BREWERS CUP

The World Brewers Cup sees international competitors prepare coffee via brewing methods other than espresso, promoting manual coffee brewing and service excellence.

In this championship, competitors prepare and serve three individual

beverages for a panel of judges. The championship consists of two rounds: a first round and a finals round. During the first round competitors complete two coffee services - a compulsory service and an open service. Lachlan Ward of St ALi Coffee Roasters is Australia's reigning Brewers Cup Champion, and will be competing for the world title this year.
