Why are we doing this & what are we protesting?

- Single-use plastic packaging in supermarkets is the largest contributor to plastic waste.
- Responsibility for supermarket plastic waste should be with brands and stores that have made it impossible avoid single-use plastic – NOT consumers!

Supermarkets can:

- Offer package free options and reuse and refill containers
- Carry reusable produce bags instead of plastic clamshells, bags, and wrappers
- Pressure brands to change their packaging

Action:

- Save plastic packaging from local supermarkets and ask friends and neighbors to join
- Join the event and bring your plastic packaging & signs if you can
- Take photos at the event and post them on social media
- Sign letters to send to CEO's demanding plastic-free options
- Sign letters asking Senator Padilla to sign the Break Free From Plastic Act. This bill will put responsibility for plastic waste where it belongs - on producers
