What to report?

Any child safety concerns of abuse or harm or general safety concerns



Call 000 if a child is in immediate danger

How to report?

Verbal

Who to report to?

What happens next?

The Safeguarding Unit, together with Pathways Victoria, will offer support to the child or person who makes the report; initiate an internal process to ensure the safety of the child; clarify and investigate the complaint; report to police or appropriate agency. Report to be made as soon as possible and all records maintained.



Outcome

Once investigation has been completed, the child, parents and relevant people will be notified of the outcome and action taken.
