An Act amending Titles 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in proceedings prior to petition to adopt, further providing for grounds for involuntary termination; and, in juvenile matters, further providing for disposition of dependent child. (Representatives KRAJEWSKI, KINSEY, CONKLIN and others) - **Children & Youth, March 27, 2024** **8**

This bill provides for grounds for involuntary termination in juvenile matters.

An Act amending Title 1 (General Provisions) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in rules of construction, further providing for definitions. (Representatives DALEY, RABB, HILL-EVANS and others) - **Commerce, April 29, 2024** **1**

This bill allows for alkaline hydrolysis, or water-based cremation, as an alternative to traditional flame cremation.

This bill amends Title 50 to provide protections for minors using social media and imposing penalties.

This bill enhances and makes more efficient the training of elected school board officials.

(Representatives FRANKEL, RABB, D. WILLIAMS and others) - Health, April 17, 2024 **2**

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

This bill creates an offense of unauthorized location tracking.

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

An Act amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act, further providing for powers and duties of the commission; providing for policies and procedures; and establishing the Human Relations Training Fund. (Representatives MADDEN, SCOTT, PROBST and others) – **Labor & Industry, April 29, 2024** **1**

This bill requires employers to adopt written policies regarding discrimination and harassment and establishes the Human Relations Training Fund.

An Act amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in preliminary provisions, providing for county property contact information list; imposing duties on chief assessors; and providing for penalties. (Representatives SOLOMON, MERSKI, SIEGEL and others) – **Local Government, March 19, 2024** **12**

This bill amends Title 68 to require individuals and businesses to submit basic information to counties when purchasing real property within the county.

This bill requires applicants for health-related licenses to submit fingerprints as part of a background check.

(Representatives BENHAM, D. MILLER, MADDEN and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, April 29, 2024 **1**

This bill defines "telecommunicator" and adds the profession to the definition of "emergency responder".

An Act amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, in interpretation and definitions, further providing for definitions; and, in liability and compensation, providing for compensation for post-traumatic stress injury. (Representatives O'MARA, SOLOMON, GILLEN and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, April 17, 2024 **2**

This bill establishes that first responders may collect workers' compensation for post-traumatic stress injuries sustained in the course and scope of their work.

This bill provides certifying agencies with clarity and consistency for providing nonimmigrant victims with documentation to use when applying for a U Visa.

This bill imposes an annual fee of \$290 per year on certain noncommercial passenger electric vehicles and provides for the Alternative Fuels Tax on Electricity.
