Covid-19 Safety plan

Protocols to Minimize the Risks of Infection

- 1. Control measures for maintaining physical distance on the premises of Tetachuck Wilderness Lodge
 - 2 m distancing rule applied every where
 - Pre-registration by e-mail, touchless payment options
 - Each group in a Cabin must be from one household unit. (Households are defined as people who live in one home and have maintained social distancing during the Covid-19 outbreak)
 - West Cabin available for self-contained only.

2. Rules and Guidelines

- Stay at home if you are sick to avoid spreading illness to others.
- Practice diligent hand hygiene at all times.
- Practice cough etiquette. Cough into your elbow or cover your mouth and nose with a
 disposable tissue when you sneeze. Immediately dispose of all used tissues in an
 appropriate waste bin and wash your hands right away.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands.
- Do not share food, drinks, utensils, cigarettes, vaping devices.
- Maintain a physical distance of two meters from others at all times
- Wash hands for at least 20 seconds in warm water and soap every time you enter or exit your unit.
- Parents must ensure that their children maintain a 2-metre (6 feet) separation at all times from other children/people.
- Dogs must be on the leash at all times.
- The hot tub is closed for all guests.

3. Cleaning practices

- Daily cleaning and disinfection of hard surfaces in Lodge common areas, high touch surfaces are cleaned twice daily.
- After guest's departure the cabin is left idle for 48 hr. before cleaning.
- Diligent cleaning and disinfection of all hard surfaces with special attention to frequently touched items such as toilets, sinks, faucets, doorknobs, light switches and garbage cans.
