SECOND CONSIDERATION AGING AND OLDER ADULT SERVICES BILL

HOUSE 1184

An Act amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, in pharmaceutical assistance for the elderly, further providing for determination of eligibility. (Representatives KIM, HILL-EVANS, SCHLOSSBERG and others) - Aging & Older Adult Services, June 12, 2023

This bill amends the State Lottery Law to extend the current Social Security COLA Moratorium for PACE/PACENET enrollees by another two years.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER PROTECTION, TECHNOLOGY AND UTILITIES BILL

HOUSE 1032 1041

An Act establishing the Solar for Schools Grant Program; and providing for powers and duties of the Department of Community and Economic Development. (Representatives FIEDLER, KAUFER, GAYDOS and others) - Consumer Protection, Technology & Utilities, June 12, 2023

This bill establishes the Solar for Schools Grant Program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

HOUSE 962 1299

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for bonding. (Representatives VITALI, BRENNAN, MADDEN and others) – Environmental Resources & Energy, June 7, 2023

This bill restores DEP/EQB authority to change bonding amounts for conventional wells.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

HOUSE 178

An Act amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; and, in taxation by school districts, further providing for school district tax notices. (Representatives PASHINSKI, HARKINS, SANCHEZ and others) - Finance, May 2, 2023

This bill clarifies the notice for Homestead and Farmstead property tax relief on property tax bills.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILL

HOUSE 1131 1186

An Act amending the act of April 27, 1905 (P.L.312, No.218), entitled "An act creating a Department of Health, and defining its powers and duties," further providing for State health centers; and making editorial changes. (Representatives BOROWSKI, PROBST, SANCHEZ and others) – Health, June 12, 2023

This bill provides to permit the closure of duplicate health centers.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HUMAN SERVICES BILL

HOUSE 931 129'

An Act amending Title 67 (Public Welfare) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in family finding and kinship care, establishing the Legal Services for Kinship Care Families Grant Program and the Legal Services for Kinship Care Families Grant Program Account; and making a transfer. (Representatives PASHINSKI, SANCHEZ, HILL-EVANS and others) – Human Services, June 12, 2023

This bill amends Title 67 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to establish the Legal Services for Kinship Care Families Grant Program and the Legal Services for Kinship Care Families Grant Program Account.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 79

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in the State System of Higher Education, further providing for definitions and for powers and duties of councils of trustees. (Representatives OWLETT, STRUZZI, AND HAMM) – Judiciary, June 5, 2023

This bill amends Act 14, known as the Public School Code, in the State System of Higher Education, further providing for definitions and for powers and duties of councils of trustees.

SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILL

HOUSE 1092 1140

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in commercial drivers, further providing for disqualification. (Representatives HILL-EVANS, MADDEN, SANCHEZ and others) – Transportation, June 12, 2023

This bill amends Title 75 to allow individuals subject to lifetime disqualification of commercial driving privileges to apply for reinstatement of commercial driving privileges with restrictions.

SECOND CONSIDERATION VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL

HOUSE 892

An Act amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes, in Department of Military Affairs,
establishing the PA VETConnect Program. (Representatives
KAUFER, CIRESI, KINSEY and others) - Veterans Affairs &
Emergency Preparedness, June 12, 2023

This bill codifies the PA VETConnect program to improve the health and well-being of veterans and their families.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BILL

HOUSE **255**

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in neighborhood blight reclamation and revitalization, providing for Municipal Codes **Enforcement Grant Program; providing for county property** maintenance code; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MERSKI, SIEGEL, MADDEN and others) - Appropriations, June 7, 2023 **Fiscal-Note Attached**

This bill establishes Municipal Property Maintenance Code Assistance Fund to provide grants to municipalities for code enforcement programs and personnel.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE **JUDICIARY BILL**

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for locking device for firearms; providing for safe storage of firearm when not in use; and imposing penalties. (Representatives PARKER, HOHENSTEIN, others) - Appropriations, May 22, 2023 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill amends Title 18 providing for locking devices for firearms.
