HOUSE 962

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for bonding. (Representatives VITALI, BRENNAN, MADDEN and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, June 7, 2023

This bill restores DEP/EQB authority to change bonding amounts for conventional wells.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

HOUSE 178

An Act amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; and, in taxation by school districts, further providing for school district tax notices. (Representatives PASHINSKI, HARKINS, SANCHEZ and others) - Finance, May 2, 2023

OVER

This bill clarifies the notice for Homestead and Farmstead property tax relief on property tax bills.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BILLS

HOUSE 711

An Act amending the act of May 16, 1923 (P.L.207, No.153), referred to as the Municipal Claim and Tax Lien Law, further providing for municipal claims first lien, cities of first class, docketing, judgment and execution, for cities of the first class, recovery of judgment and sale free from claims, for redemption and for rule to show cause, decree, service and notice and providing for disposition of property in cities of the second class. (Representatives KINKEAD, BURGOS, HILL-EVANS and others) – Housing & Community Development, June 7, 2023

VOTE

This bill extends the Municipal Tax Claims and Lien Law to cities and counties of the second class and their land banks to acquire and sale blighted and abandoned properties.

HOUSE 788

An Act amending the act of December 13, 1988 (P.L.1190, No.146), known as the First and Second Class County Property Tax Relief Act, further providing for short title, for definitions, for deferral or exemption authority and for retroactive application. (Representatives INNAMORATO, KINKEAD, GIRAL and others) - Housing & Community Development, June 07, 2023 1

VOITE

This bill provides Pittsburgh with the option to enact the Longtime Owner Occupant Tax Exemption Program.

This bill extends the time when a veteran's record of discharge may not be disclosed.
