NOTICE OF RACE

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply when boats are in the racing area, and on their way to and from the racing area.
- 1.3. RRS 56.2 is deleted
- 1.4. US Sailing Prescriptions 63.1 and 63.2 are deleted.

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all Mercury, Santana 22, Alerion 28, J/105 and J/24 boats whose skipper is a member in good standing of their respective class. Classes must have a minimum of six (6) boats registered before 1700 on 9/22/21 to qualify for a start.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.stfyc.com, before 0900 hours on Saturday 9/25/21. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

The sailing instructions will be available online before the competitors' meeting at www.stfyc.com.

The intended race area will be set on the San Francisco City Front utilizing fixed and temporary inflatable marks.

7.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.2. A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.

All boats competing in the event may be stored free of charge at StFYC during the event as well as one day before and one day after. If you plan on leaving a trailer in the parking lot, you need to obtain an overnight parking permit from the StFYC Race Office when you arrive. All boats & trailers shall be stored at the direction of the StFYC Dockmaster.

The Joe Logan Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the Mercury class.

10.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions

of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

- 10.2.** Additionally, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and race officials the right to use their personal contact information, including but not limited to a current email address and cell phone number, for the purpose of race administration and regatta communications.

By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
