With an impressive career spanning various key roles in the public sector, Ms. Moriani brings a wealth of experience and strategic insight to lead PSEB into its next chapter of growth and innovation.

On 14 march, 2024, Minister of State for IT and Telecommunication Shaza Fatima Khawaja chaired a meeting held at the Ministry IT. Secretary IT Mr. Hassan Nasir Jamy, Additional Secretary/CEO PSEB Ms. Aisha Humera Moriani, and senior officers of the Ministry of IT were present in the meeting.

The meeting was briefed on the working and programs of the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB). PSEB authorities informed the officials present that over 6,000 IT companies are registered with the Board, and a total of 43 Software Technology Parks (STPs) have been established throughout the country, with 357 IT/ITes companies currently operating within these STPs.

EXCITING UPDATE!

COMPANIES CAN NOW APPLY TO UPGRADE THEIR TALENT ACQUISITION EFFORTS WITH THE IT INDUSTRY CO-OPT PROGRAM!

This developed program, in collaboration with the IT sector, is facilitated by the Pakistan Software Houses Association (PASHA) for student placements in IT companies. Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) has partnered with Higher Education Commission (HEC) to enhance the program, offering 3 to 6 credit hours in lieu of apprenticeship. Students will engage in live projects at software houses. Additionally, the Ministry of IT & Telecom (MOITT) proposes that project/apprenticeship work be endorsed by one IT sector expert and two university professors for quality assurance.

Interested companies can apply through: apprenticeship.pseb.org.pk to join the program. Large number of companies have shown interest and PSEB is taking applications from interested companies for a limited extended time.

PSEB PROJECT UPDATES

SKILLS & CAPACITY BUILDING

IT

STANDARDIZATION OF

This initiative seeks to certify 100 call centers in ISO 18295, offering a 90% subsidy for PSEB registered call centers to enhance value creation for the organization, customers, and employees. Presently, 60 call centers have successfully enrolled in ISO 18295 certification programs.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The project aims to deploy 3500 ICT & non-ICT graduates across Pakistan in the IT & ITeS Industry for a maximum period of six (06) months with monthly stipend of PKR 20,000/-. 2744 interns deployed and over 50% have been retained so far.

CERTIFICATION OF IT PROFESSIONALS

To cultivate a profoundly proficient talent reservoir within the Pakistani IT sector. This will be achieved by offering advanced-level technical training and certifications to a target group of 10,000 IT professionals and graduates. Over 5693 trainings and certifications have been completed so far.

RAISING SMART CAPITAL THROUGH PSX

This project aims to list 40 Pakistani IT companies on GEM Board of Pakistan Stock Exchange. The goal is to increase the number of listed technology companies on PSX Main Board & GEM Board which would in turn help to strengthen the financial ecosystem for IT/ITeS sector growth. 07 companies have submitted their Expression of Interest (EOI) for GEM BOARD listing, and their applications are currently under review. The Pakistan Stock Exchange (PSX) has also disseminated the proposed amendments in the GEM Board regulations to the general public, following our consultative session on GEM BOARD regulations.

GDPR COMPLIANCE

This project intends to facilitate 50 IT/ITeS companies to comply with GDPR requirements by achieving ISO27001 and ISO27701 certifications at a 70% cost subsidy. 50 companies have been enrolled for these certifications and 25 IT companies have been certified for ISO 27001 and ISO 27701 standards so far, while 25 companies are in the process of these certifications.

CERTIFICATION PROGRAM BY NAVTTC

Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) has collaborated with NAVTTC to formulate a certification program aligning with industry demands under the PSDP scheme, Prime Minister's Youth Initiative. This initiative aims to provide over 16,000 trainings, predominantly in certifications from Multi National Corporations (MNCs). PSEB has put forth a reimbursement model to support the training of IT graduates within the framework of this PSDP scheme.

12,000 trainings have been awarded by NAVTCC through this scheme. With a revised criteria, NAVTTC is soliciting interests of IT companies to be part of this training scheme for next batch of 5000 trainings. Details are available at NAVTTC official portal and PSEB team can also be reached to get connected to NAVTTC executing Office. NAVTTC is also planning industry interactions to assess skills demand, shortly.

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

Infrastructure Development includes the following projects and initiatives to support and facilitate ICT Industry of Pakistan to create jobs, increase IT export and promote ICT ecosystem.

ESTABLISHMENT OF IT PARK KARACHI

The design phase for construction of IT Park Karachi is under process by Korean Design Consortium i.e. M/S JUNGLIM Consortium. The concept, schematic and initial design (both architecture and ICT) is completed, and detail design shall be completed in May 2024. The construction of project shall be started in FY 24-25 and shall be completed in July 2027.

CONVERSION OF BUILDING INTO SOFTWARE TECHNOLOGY PARKS (STPS)

During the first quarters of FY 2024, the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) has implemented several measures to support the IT industry by enhancing basic infrastructure facilities in secondary and tertiary cities of Pakistan. In achieving this objective one more Software Technology Parks (STPs) have been added during this period and achieving a remarkable number of 43 fully functional STPs across Pakistan.

CONVERSION OF PUBLIC SECTOR BUILDINGS INTO STP AND UPGRADATION OF THE FACILITY (CAPEX)

Under this initiative, a software technology park in Women University of Bagh, Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) is in progress to make it first-ever women-only technology park in Pakistan. This project is designed to provide business as well as job opportunities to women of this area in ICT sector.

ESTABLISHMENT OF SOFTWARE TECHNOLOGY PARKS IN MODEL COLLEGES OF ISLAMABAD

This strategic initiative undertook to establish a collaboration with the Federal

Ministry of Education for establishment of STP/e-Rozgaar centers within the premises of (05) five model colleges in Islamabad. This initiative, led by the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) is designed to foster innovation, entrepreneurship, and technological advancements in the region.

PSDP PROJECT TITLED "PRIME MINISTER'S INITIATIVES - SUPPORT FOR IT STARTUPS, SPECIALIZED IT TRAININGS AND VENTURE CAPITAL" (E-ROZGAAR)

PC-I of the project has been approved and PSEB is to establishment of 250 e-Rozgaar centers through public & private partnership model, across Pakistan.

DOMESTIC EVENTS

TECHDESTINATION PAKISTAN REJUVENATED

On January 11, 2024, at the Jinnah Convention Center in Islamabad, the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) held an event to launch the E-Rozgar Centers initiative nationwide. Caretaker Prime Minister Anwaarul Haq Kakar inaugurated the first E-Rozgar Center, aimed at providing freelancing opportunities to the youth. This initiative aligns with the government's Digital Policy, which aims to bring about economic prosperity through digitization. The Prime Minister also commended PSEB's efforts in increasing the number of Software Technology Parks and assured full support to explore the untapped potential of the country's IT industry.



IT & ITES EXPORT AWARDS 2024

On February 13, 2024, at Falleti's Hotel in Lahore, an event was held to celebrate excellence in the IT and IT-enabled services (ITeS) sector. Organized by the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB), the prestigious awards ceremony aimed to recognize and incentivize IT exports, thereby fostering growth in the industry. The event was graced by the presence of the Honorable Minister of Information Technology, Dr. Umar Saif, who personally presented cash prizes to the top 550 IT exporters that demonstrated positive growth in their exports during Q2 of FY 2023-24 compared to Q1. These exporters collectively brought in \$365 million in export remittance receipts during the first six months of FY 2023-24, showing an increase of \$97 million from Q1 to Q2 of FY 2023-24. Additionally, awards were distributed in 8 other categories within the IT/ITeS industry.

INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

WEB SUMMIT, DOHA

PSEB facilitated the participation of 9 Pakistani IT companies at the Web Summit Doha, which took place on February 26-29, 2024, in Doha, Qatar, aiming to attract investment, business, and strengthen bilateral ties between Pakistan and Qatar. The event, marked by the inauguration of the Pakistan Pavilion by Muhammad Aejaz, Ambassador of Pakistan to the State of Qatar, and Muhammad Zohaib Khan, Chairman of P@SHA, served as a platform for these companies to explore the Qatari market and align with Qatar's Vision 2023. This collaborative effort promises future growth and success for Pakistan's IT industry.



LEAP 2024

The Pakistan contingent was among the most substantial at LEAP 2024, which took place on March 4-7, 2024, in Riyadh, boasting a total of 74 companies from Pakistan and over 800 delegates. The Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB), in collaboration with TDAP and PASHA, established a 162-square-meter Tech Destination Pakistan Pavilion, which accommodated 27 companies and provided meeting spaces. PSEB and TDAP also offered a 35% subsidy on the exhibition cost, demonstrating their commitment to supporting the participating companies. The "Saudi-Pak Tech Forum" was organized on March 3, 2024, by PSEB and P@SHA, in collaboration with the Pakistan Embassy in Riyadh and other stakeholders. This forum was graced by the presence of Secretary General DCO Ms. Deemah Alyahya as the Chief Guest. The event was well-

attended by a significant number of Saudi Government and private institutions. 8 MOUs and 1 contract were signed between Pakistani companies and global counterparts. The CEO of PSEB also held pivotal meetings with high-ranking officials from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA), paving the way for future collaborations. Key discussions with the Ministry of Communication and Information Technology (MCIT) underscored the potential for bilateral collaboration and highlighted Pakistan's capability to meet the diverse needs of KSA's evolving economy.



GAME DEVELOPERS CONFERENCE 2024

Pakistan made a significant impact at the Game Development Conference, marking a significant milestone in Pakistan's journey towards becoming an emerging player in the global gaming industry. The Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB), in collaboration with TDAP, established a 37 sqm TechdestiNation Pakistan Pavilion at GDC 2024, which took place on March 18-22, 2024, accommodating 6 companies with a 60% participation cost subsidy for each participating company.



FOCUS GROUP ONLINE SESSIONS

SESSION ON FINTECH

PSEB is actively engaged in strengthening the IT industry of Pakistan through a multifaceted approach. As the fintech sector in Pakistan has grown exceptionally in the recent past and has gained prominence as a priority area for the Government of Pakistan, PSEB conducted an online session with prominent fintech players of Pakistan and the Pakistan Fintech Network (PFN) on March 19, 2024, to share their challenges and provide recommendations to be shared with the relevant regulatory authorities for building an ecosystem that flourishes this sector.

SESSION ON BPO

Pakistan emerges as a competitive outsourcing destination. With the Government's focus to uplift this sector, PSEB arranged a session with prominent BPOs of Pakistan on March 19, 2024, to share their challenges and provide appropriate recommendations.

SESSION ON INTERNATIONAL MARKETING

PSEB conducted an insightful discussion on March 21,2024 with the IT industry regarding the marketing initiatives being undertaken, including the list of shortlisted International Tech Events for the upcoming year. This discussion yielded valuable suggestions and recommendations, which PSEB has duly noted for enhancing their strategies.


