Ash Wednesday Communion Service this week (6 p.m.).

All baptized and affirming believers who have previously been approved and prepared to discern and partake of the Body, and active in fellowship with our church OR ANY OTHER CHURCH professing personal faith in salvation through Jesus Christ: We invite you to a focused time of spiritual renewal, in preparation for your sharing Holy Communion. God's Word instructs that our preparation includes repentance, through reconciliation to God and to others (particularly fellow believers from whom you may have become estranged), and through trusting in God's grace in all things.

(a) Jesus Knew and Counted the Cost – in the Light of His Glory, His Love, and His Joy.


