Others may be Open Access. Members may wish to regularly read a particular journal in order to keep updated in a specific area of interest.

Whilst this medium is becoming less popular there is still content being created and a demand from members. DVDs provide a form of hands-on case study learning that can be watched, for free, at a time convenient to the member.
