LESSON 1

After listening to the message, take a few moments to pray and ask the Holy Spirit to guide your discussion.

Expand your capacity to receive the fact that when God is giving answers to the world's problems, He is doing it through people.

Matthew 13:24-30; 36-43

Discuss the various dimensions of the Kingdom as represented by the seed.

- What should we be asking God to show us?

Describe the difference between an “office” and a “gift.”

How should we go about cleaning up the dirty places of the world?

- What are we carriers of?

Discuss what makes it possible for you to give God the glory.

- What should we strive to become?
 - How do we add value to the world around us?

Describe what the “good seed” represents.

- Describe what is represented by “the field.”

How is what we learn from this parable relevant to the function of the Church?

- Take a few moments to share about the field where God has planted you.

With what kind of paradigm should we approach every aspect of the world?

- How should we pray when we approach God?

What does the world need?

- Discuss what we learn from this message about leadership.
 - Describe what we learn about what a leader does.

Share and pray about what each person must do wherever God has placed him or her.
