Guidelines for HRI Educational Grant applications

Application deadline: 11 April 2017

The HRI Educational Grant scheme provides financial support to applicants wishing to improve their knowledge of homeopathy research.

HRI International Homeopathy Research Conferences are held every two years. In years when there is an HRI Conference, HRI grants are awarded to support attendance of this event only.

In the alternate years, calls will be made for applications for grants towards attendance of homeopathy research events run by external organisations. Eligibility criteria for applications to external events will be made available in late 2017.

We are now calling for applications for an HRI Educational Grant towards **HRI Malta 2017 only**. Each grant awarded will be **£500**.

Applications are open to those involved in the study, practice or teaching of homeopathy and/or scientific research.

The scheme is generously funded by the UK-based charity Manchester Homeopathic Clinic; at their request, applications are restricted to **UK residents only**.

Application process

Format: Word format double spaced, maximum one page A4, 12 font, Arial.

Successful applicants will be selected on merit and results will be announced by **20th April.**
