've told a few of you before about our family trip to Iowa to visit relatives. We stayed with our Uncle and Aunt and their two daughters – going to church with them that first weekend, and seeing a lot of farmland that surrounded the small town they lived in.

After we got back home, I received a small package from them – some religious books, including a Bible. It was their inscription in the Bible that I remember to this very day: My uncle wrote, "This is our wish for you" – and he underlined Philippians 1:9-11...

And this is my prayer for you – that your love will overflow more and more, and that you will keep growing in knowledge and understanding. For I want you to understand what really matters, so that you may live pure and blameless lives until the day of Christ's return. May you always be filled with the fruit of your salvation – the righteous character produced in your life by Jesus Christ – for this will bring much glory and praise to God.

My uncle and aunt did not know I would hear and follow God's call for me into His ministry – or maybe by insight from His Holy Spirit, they did – I'll never know until I see them in heaven. But this I do know – they gave me my first insight to the truths contained in Paul's letter to the church in Philippi. It's my favorite book from God's Word to us. Over the next couple of months, we will take time to look at the different truths our Lord has given us – looking at how He calls us to reframe our lives, according to His will for us.

Please take time to read through the 4 chapters of this book – read those chapters each week, so that we're familiar with it – pray that we get to know Jesus more intimately as we study together. Chapter one, verse six sums it up:

And I am certain that God, who began a good work in you, will bring it to completion in the day of Christ Jesus. Amen.

Hello from your Missions Elder!

As I write this newsletter, I am at Bweyale Village, Secondary and Vocational School of <u>Village of Hope</u> (VOH.) I am really enjoying my time, observing classrooms and meeting with teachers during the day, and working with students in the evenings. I've met up with a team from Baylife Church from Tampa, Florida. The leader of the team is Dave Boyce, a member of the board of directors. His wife, Camalita, is here with him, and two women both named Jennifer round out the team. They have been working with staff from both villages on personality surveys and conflict resolution techniques, The staff have been really appreciative and uplifted by their visit! This team moves on early next week and another joins me here so we will see what that brings! We will leave shortly after they arrive for Bobi Village, a bit further north, where I will be able to see my good friend Evassy and her family whom I have shared about with you.

There are a few updates from the prayer requests that I asked for in the recent past. Rose has been slowly recovering from her motorcycle accident and although it has been slow going, she is now doing far better and was able to dance with the students at the welcome celebration yesterday! It is so good to see her feeling better!

The woman who lost the baby in the village due to being hit with a cart while transporting water is doing ok, but her husband still is trying to sue VOH. Not sure how that will go. The good news is that there is no need to transport water like that now as we have a 2nd well that provides water to the far side of the village where they were having to transport water so far.

The family of the little girl that was killed from getting hit by a car is still trying to get justice from the woman that hit her, but it likely won't happen due to the high rank of the woman's husband. VOH helped the family with funeral expenses, but that doesn't go far with the death of a child.

An amazing thing that happened on this trip is that I was able to meet up with a "friend of a friend" and bring some items from the US for the orphanage where he works. One of my friends in Hillsboro met a man from Uganda on Facebook a couple of years ago when asking for prayer. They have kept in contact and she had been wanting to send a few backpacks full of items for the children at the orphanage. So I got the backpacks from her and connected with this man, Robin, on messenger. He lives about two hours west of Entebbe where we fly in from the US. This young man, 23 years old, took a taxi and a Bota Bota (motorcycle), then walked the remaining way to the hotel where I was staying, timing it for the morning we were leaving for the village. He had never been to Entebbe, never seen lake Victoria, never been that far from home! But he made the journey to meet me and receive the backpack. We met for all of about 45 minutes, then we had to be on our way. We were able to take him to the place in the road where it splits - one way to Kampala (where we needed to pass through) and one way to Mityana, where he needed to go. We dropped him there, literally on the side of the "freeway" and he walked to where he could get a taxi. This young man is dedicated to his orphan children and to our Lord, Jesus Christ. What an inspiration!! Hopefully we will be able to connect again!

There will be so much more to share when I return at the end of the month. I will be at church on July 9th and I look forward to seeing all of you! Thank you so very much for all of your prayers and support not only for me, but for the children and staff at Village of Hope!
