

# 3. USE

**Power. Boot. Select. Begin.**



Save anything you want to keep elsewhere before using Redkey on the target device. No data survives the wipe! Do not remove the key during use. After completion, fully power down the device before removing the key.

## FOR LAPTOP, DESKTOP PCs

Insert Redkey into a USB port

Turn on the computer

Repeatedly press the Boot Menu key (usually F12 or Esc)

Choose Redkey / USB from the menu

Follow the on-screen instructions



## FOR APPLE COMPUTERS

Insert Redkey into USB port

Power on computer

At the chime, hold the Option key.

Select EFI Boot

Follow on-screen instructions



## FOR DELL PCs WITH NVMe

Enable AHCI Mode within the BIOS Setup menu

Power on, press F2 to enter BIOS

Go to SATA Operation

Change RAID mode to AHCI mode.

Save changes and exit BIOS

Reboot with Redkey inserted

Follow PC instructions above



## FOR APPLE PCs WITH T2 CHIP

Access Startup Security Utility

Power on, hold Cmd + R to enter Recovery

Sign in if prompted

From menu, open Utilities > Startup Security Utility

Allow booting from external/removable media

Reboot with Redkey inserted

Follow Apple instructions above
