# **Quick Start HOW TO USE YOUR REDKEY**



Just a friendly reminder: Don't forget to back up any important data you actually want to keep before wiping everything. Once it's gone. gone forever!

# FOR LAPTOP, DESKTOP PCs

- Insert the Redkey into a spare USB port
- Power on the computer
- Press the Boot Menu key repeatedly
- (usually [f12], [esc], or whatever key works)
- Select the USB from the boot menu
  - Follow the on-screen instructions



# FOR APPLE COMPUTERS

- Insert the Redkey into a spare USB port
- Power on the computer
- At the Chime sound, hold down the [Option] key
- Select 'EFI Boot' from the options
- Follow the on-screen instructions



#### FOR DELL PCs WITH NVMe Enable AHCI Mode within the BIOS Setup menu

Power on your computer, Press the BIOS key repeatedly

- (usually [del], [f2], or whatever key works) Locate the 'SATA operation' menu
- Select 'AHCI Mode' (the wording may vary)
- Apply the changes and exit the BIOS
- Follow the regular PC wiping process above
- Revert the settings after the wipe



#### FOR APPLE PCs WITH T2 CHIP

Access Startup Security Utility

- Power on the computer. After the Apple logo appears...
- Press the [Command] & [R] keys at the same time
- In the 'Utilities' menu, select the 'Startup Security Utility'
- For Secure boot: Select 'No Security'
- For External Boot: Select 'Allow
- Back out and restart the computer
- Follow the Apple process above Revert the settings after the wipe
