# **MEET: The Pool**



The Scene: Take a dip at the Rooftop L.O.A. Pool, a first-of-its-kind, 21+ rooftop pool in Atlanta where guests are invited to soak up the sun, swim, and enjoy bites and libations all day... and into the night. Complete with loungers, private cabanas and a VIP alcove, the Pool is the ultimate Atlanta hotspot with endless views of the city skyline. If that's not enough, tucked away beneath the pool's perimeter, guests are invited to step down and experience multi-tier, stadium-style seating with a glass barrier to the sky. Outfitted for entertainment like music and movies, the Pool also features a 12'x7' LCD screen and a DJ booth overlooking the Pool for endless rooftop fun.

The Space: The resort-style Pool, which is heated by solar power, is 1,200 square feet surrounded by a 3,600-square-foot pool deck and a 3,600-square-foot Pool bar and lounge, which includes a fire pit terrace. Guests can order drinks from the Pool bar inside, or through a pool deck window. At a depth of 4 feet, no diving is allowed in the Pool, and there will be no lifeguards on duty. For an easy transition from poolside to fireside or tableside, facilities are available, including showers and locker rooms. Guests access the rooftop through an elevator entrance on the Plaza level of The Interlock and are greeted at a spa-inspired welcome desk on the top floor.

The Amenities: For maximum relaxation and luxury, guests are encouraged to make reservations for lounge chairs and cabanas in advance online at <u>rooftoploa.com</u>. Upon entering the Pool deck, an amenities desk is available for towel rentals as well as lounge chair and cabana inquiries and customer services. Towels cost \$6 per person for the day and lounge chair rentals, which include a towel, cost \$40 per two and a half hours. Cabana rentals, which accommodate 4-6 guests and include up to six towels plus complimentary seasonal fruit, start at \$425 for three and a half hours. Reservations for loungers and cabanas can be made in advance with a deposit online, and additional general Pool access is released daily at <u>rooftoploa.com/reservations</u>.



"The Pool at Rooftop L.O.A. is a huge part of what makes this concept unique to Atlanta," said Slater Hospitality Founder + CCO, Mandy Slater. "A pool that is detached from a hotel or a residence creates a special offering that doesn't exist currently. We can't wait to welcome guests and offer a truly world-class experience – a slice of paradise where guests can escape, unwind, be taken care of, and detach from the day-to-day."

The Menu: Poolside dining takes Rooftop L.O.A.'s Pool experience to the next level with a menu that incorporates the same focus on high quality ingredients and dining experience inspired by Coastal Europe in a more relaxed setting. An all-day menu is available for lunch and evening, and a late-night menu is available after 10 p.m. with poolside service or bar and lounge service. Guests can enjoy delicious handhelds like foie gras bratwurst and shrimp tacos, plus an ancient grains bowl. "Whim-sicles," are Rooftop L.O.A. popsicles including a mango paleta, and boozier options such as Pina Colada with dark chocolate and the Blueberry gel squeeze shot. Brunch is also available at the Pool on Saturday and Sunday. Menu items include a French pastry selection and Gougere Benedict with prosciutto cotto and hollandaise. Brunch-goers can also build their own egg breakfast with potato galette, bacon, fruit and more.

"Cocktails at the Pool are designed to match the environment. Expect fresh, tropical libations such as a passionfruit mezcal cocktail served over a watermelon ice cube and frozen ginger-carrot margarita," said Rooftop L.O.A. Beverage Manager, Colten Murray. "The Pool is also the perfect place to enjoy ice cold champagne and sparkling wine from our extensive wine list."
