- Foods prepared off-site must be made in a kitchen that meets the Boone County Health Department standards. Products may be made by the Vendor in a certified kitchen or in a home-based kitchen that meets the risk and labeling requirements of the Boone County Health Department.
- For artisanal and ready-to-eat foods, priority is given to vendors who utilize local ingredients. Products may be made by the Vendor in a certified kitchen or in a home-based kitchen that meets the risk and labeling requirements of the Boone County Health Department.

V. HCF Obligations

Per the stated Vendor/Sponsorship plan as determined by the Sponsor in section I of this Agreement. The HCF will provide the Sponsor with all the Vendor/Sponsorship benefits as it is outlined and stated in the Vendor/Sponsorship packet. If HCF is unable to fulfill one of the Vendor/Sponsorship benefits as it is noted in the Vendor/Sponsorship packet, HCF will provide a replacement benefit that is mutually agreeable to both the Sponsor and HCF. Additionally, HCF will ensure that notification of a change of benefits will occur at the earliest possible convenience.



VI. Sponsor Obligations

VII. Sponsor Trademarks and Materials

Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Sponsor grants the HCF the right to use the Sponsor's trade names, logo designs, trademarks, and company descriptions as provided in Sponsor marketing materials. These assets may be used in any medium of advertising, promotional products, or marketing materials distributed solely in connection with the 2023 Hoosier Chocolate Fest event. HCF agrees to use materials according to Sponsor's trademark usage guidelines.

The Sponsor agrees to offer the following materials for marketing and promotional purposes:

VIII. Indemnity

- 5.1 The Sponsor will indemnify, defend, and hold the HCF harmless from and against any claims relating directly or indirectly to or arising out of, content posted on the Sponsor's respective website, use of Sponsor materials, or use of Sponsor's logos and trademarks.
- 5.2 The HCF will not be responsible for damage to or loss of property belonging to the Sponsor, its employees, contractors, or agents or for personal injury to the Sponsor's employees, contractors, agents, directors, or invitees except to the extent that claims may be solely and directly attributed to willful misconduct or gross negligence of the HCF and HCF's employers, directors, or officers.
- 5.3 The Sponsor will give HCF prompt written notice of any suit or claim that comes within the purview of these indemnities.

IX. Limitation of Liability

In no event shall either party be liable to the other party for any consequential, incidental, indirect, or punitive damages regardless of whether such liability results from a breach of contract, breach of warranties, tort, strict liability, or otherwise.



X. Term and Termination

- 7.1 This Agreement will be valid for the period of October 1, 2022, through December 31, 2023. Following the event, HCF will keep the hoosierchocolatefest.com website live, with all sponsors listed until 180 days before the next Hoosier Chocolate Fest event.
- 7.2 The HCF may terminate this Agreement at any time for any reason. In the event that the HCF terminates this Agreement for any reason other than Sponsor's breach of Agreement, the HCF shall refund any fees received from the Sponsor and return any materials, equipment, hardware, or software loaned by the Sponsor for the event, at the Sponsor's expense.
- 7.3 The Sponsor may terminate this Agreement for breach of Agreement by the HCF after giving HCF at least ten (10) days prior written notice specifying the nature of the breach and providing the HCF at least ten (10) days to resolve such breach. If printed marketing materials or social media ads listing the Sponsors name have already been distributed, HCF will pull the sponsor's name from future materials, but no portion of the Vendor/Sponsorship fee will be returned. If a breach occurs less than ten (10) days before the event, the Sponsor may terminate this Agreement if a breach is not resolved by the date before the event but will receive no refund of any fees received from the Sponsor.

XI. Disagreement

In the case of a disagreement at any point, the parties will refer the matter to an independent arbitrator appointed by mutual agreement.

XII. Miscellaneous

- 9.1 This Agreement will supersede any or all prior oral or written forms of understanding between the Sponsor and HCF. This Agreement may not be amended or modified except when one or both parties execute amendments in writing, and amendments are signed by both parties.
- 9.2 This Agreement shall be governed by and executed in accordance with the laws of the County of Hamilton in the State of Indiana applicable to agreements made and to be performed entirely within this state.
- 9.3 The terms and conditions of this Agreement shall not be divulged to any third party without prior written approval from both parties.
