- 3. Briefly share about another Christian that has inspired you with their selflessness. What did that selflessness look like as they walked with Christ?
- 4. How does Paul summarize the message he has been preaching in verses 21 and 24? Based on these verses and other letters Paul wrote in the New Testament, what was Paul's basic message?
- 5. In verse 30 Paul warns that others will come in and distort the truth. What are some subtle (or not so subtle) distortions of the gospel that you have heard?
- 6. Practically, what can you and I do to make sure that we are getting the message right?
- 7. Paul says in verse 26 that he is "innocent of the blood of all men."
 - Does this statement seem out of place to you?
 - Why does he say this?
 - And, what does this mean—specifically, what does this tell us about our duty in proclaiming God's message?
- 8. Name one concrete way in which you might grow in either selflessness for the gospel, or in protecting the God's message without distortion.
