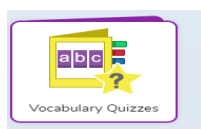

Year 3

- Design a shelter that would be suitable to survive in an alpine region. Think about the most important things that someone would need to survive the weather conditions of an alpine region. What materials will your shelter be made from? Where would it be located in the alpine region?
- You've heard of skiing and snowboarding. Create another fun, adrenaline-filled activity that people can do in an alpine region that they can't do in Birmingham. Design the equipment needed too and describe its purpose.
- Research ski tourism in the alpine regions. Create a fact file on what is needed for a safe and enjoyable ski resort. Think about the safety features used to prevent people from being harmed. Also include the jobs that people live in alpine regions have.

Year 4

- Design a mythical creature. Which animals' body parts could you include in your design? What personality will your creature have? Make your creature using junk materials and give it a fabulous name.
- Look carefully at the shapes of the letters of the Greek alphabet. Practise forming them and pronouncing them. Can you teach the alphabet to your family?
- Be inspired by Greek art! Look at online examples of pottery and create a design for an ancient Greek jug or bowl. You could choose a scene from Greek mythology to represent in your artwork or maybe another familiar story. Remember to use colours typical of Greek art, such as black, white, red and yellow.
- Read about Narcissus, the young man who fell in love with his own reflection. What is the moral of the story? Write a letter to Narcissus, telling him to change his ways!

Homework

- Taste some traditional Greek dishes such as moussaka, figs, goat's cheese or taramasalata. Write a food review, describing what you have eaten.

Year 5

- Create a 3D volcano using recyclable resources.
- Create a map and locate the different volcanoes in the world.
- Research the cause of earthquakes and create a report on your findings.
- Research about volcanoes and create a report on your findings.
- Imagine you are a newspaper reporter, write a newspaper article on a recent earthquake or volcanic eruption.
- Research different science experiment, which demonstrates a volcanic eruption and create your own.
- Create a video explaining the cause of a volcano or earthquake.
- Create a quiz on natural disasters.
- Research natural disasters and there causes.
- Create a fact file booklet on natural disasters.
