State Grants Investments Local Affordable Housing

Provides grants to local governments and nonprofits around the state to buy land and develop affordable housing in communities disproportionately impacted by COVID-19.

\$150M SB22-159

Revolving Loan Fund Invest Affordable Housing

Creates a revolving loan program to finance affordable workforce housing, senior housing, housing designed for people living with disabilities and more.

\$40M HB22-1282

Innovative Housing Incentive Program

Boosts the affordable housing supply and increases homeownership rates by attracting and supporting the construction of innovative forms of affordable housing.

\$35M SB22-160

Loan Program Resident Owned Communities

Ensures the long term affordability of mobile home parks by helping residents buy their land and create resident-owned communities.

\$25M SB22-146

CHFA Middle Income Access Program

Expands critical workforce housing so that middle-income families can access affordable housing in the communities they work in.
