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The idea for camp blossomed in early 1994 when two teenage transplant recipients Laura Brunson and Brian Jeffers, along with their parents, conceived the idea of a camp to bridge the gap between a childhood of chronic illness to a young adult life of health and productivity.

Our mission is to provide camps and programs at no cost for children, teens, young adults and their families living with a transplant. We create a fun and educational environment for heart, kidney, liver & other solid organ recipients that encourages positive self-image and healthy transplant living.

Receiving a transplant is a rare event and those who we serve can be the only people in their schools, churches and communities who have experienced the challenges of organ failure and transplantation. Our specialized camps help pediatric transplant recipients and their families return to routine life experiences. Due to special medical requirements and financial challenges facing them attending traditional summer camp is not an option- as such our camp which is provided at no cost allows them to spend time with others with similar challenges in life. For the first time, they can talk about the big and little challenges of having a transplant, or being a parent or a sibling of a child with a transplant with others who have been there and share problems and solutions with each other; and facilitate an opportunity to build a life-long support group. Thankfully, your support will help ensure that our camps are a consistent part of their transplant journey and that of the new recipients for years to come!

Transplant Journeys of Hope



When I found out our daughter was going to lose her kidney, it was devastating. My daughter had lost one kidney to cancer and the disease had come back aggressive in her remaining kidney. The only option was to remove the organ so the cancer would not spread. I understood the concept of why we were doing it but it was hard to accept. She was only 3 and about to start dialysis. I shut down. I didn't want to hear about how other parents dealt with this. So when Camp Bridges was first introduced to me, I declined. I declined again and again until a family from our hometown convinced us to go. It was the best decision of our lives. For an entire weekend, I was surrounded with people that felt like me, hurt like me and were sometimes exhausted just like me. It was amazing. And for my child ... there were children with scars and taking loads of medicines JUST LIKE HER! Camp Bridges changed our life. It helped us to deal with the many changes that had evolved and also find out different coping strategies from other families that experienced the same. For my daughter, she was able to link with other children and create relationships that are still strong even now! This camp is a blessing to all transplants! - *Mom of Kidney Recipient*

At my 6 week old check up, it was noticed that I was beginning to look jaundice. After being diagnosed with Biliary Artesia, I was put on the waiting list for a new liver! On November 4, 1995 when I was 14 months old I received my second chance at life. Shortly after my transplant I was diagnosed with PTLD which is a post transplant malignancy and had to receive 30+ surgeries to remove the cancer from my abdomen. I attended Camp Bridges Teen Camp from the time I was 12 up until 18 as a camper. Camp Bridges was the place that made me love myself, be proud of how I am, and that my scars on my body tell my story! I then came back as a counselor in hopes to make a difference in other campers lives as my counselors did for me. This coming up year will be my fourth year as a counselor and 3rd year as a Young Adult Camper- it is the one thing I look forward to doing each and every year! Camp Bridges has made a huge impact on my life. I have met so many great friends and I get a chance to learn something new from each person every year! Right after school started when Quendarius turned 10 I began to notice my son's diminished appetite and languid attitude toward physical activity. A chest X-ray in November of that year revealed he had an enlarged heart. He was transported to Children's Hospital in Birmingham, where his condition deteriorated and he experienced a stroke that temporarily paralyzed the right side of his body. It was all shocking! After some time in the hospital he was sent home on medications so his heart could get stronger. When this did not happen he was admitted to the hospital and placed on the heart transplant list. One month later during a five hour surgery he received his new heart. Quendarius and I stayed the next two and a half weeks at the hospital before spending another six weeks with the Ronald McDonald House Charities of Alabama. Once home he had to adjust to a life with physical limitations. Quendarius will be on anti-rejection medications for the rest of his life. At Teen Camp my son spends the week with other 13-18 year olds who have the same type of medication routine and who bear similar surgical "scars". Our family also attends Family Camp and it is a blessing to spend the weekend with others who have been through the same thing as us and makes us realize we are not alone. We are thankful that Camp BRIDGES is a part of our lives. - *Mom of Heart Recipient*
