

Release note for Device Manager 2.5.0

Notes

In order to connect to BlackTrax, Device Manager must be running on the same machine and BlackTrax must be at least v2.5.0 BETA or later. As this version is 64-bit it will not work with previous versions of BlackTrax.

System Requirements:

- PC running Windows 10 x64 or newer
- Intel Core i3 2.0GHz or equivalent AMD processor
- 2GB RAM
- 200MB of free space
- Network Port with a 10.133.5.X IP address

Major changes:

- 64-Bit
- Bug fixes

Known issues:

- IP addresses of Charging Stations don't always refresh when changing IDs (the ID still does, and the new IP address does take affect it just doesn't display);
 Reboot Device Manager to get around this issue for now
- Beacon battery and radio status won't refresh unless 'Refresh Selection' is pressed



Features and Fixes:

Bug

- Fixed: Device Manager would sometimes crash if Get Beacon List was pressed too many times
- Fixed: Beacons would not appear if they started up in Bootloader mode





- Fixed: The longer Device Manager was open/refreshing the Beacon list, the more RAM Device Manager would use
- Fixed: Device Manager was not saving configuration files in the proper directories; files are now stored in C:\bt_run_time\release\Device Manager

New Feature

- Device Manager is now 64-bit to maintain compatibility with the main BlackTrax software
 - As such, Device Manager is now installed in Program Files instead of Program Files (x86)
