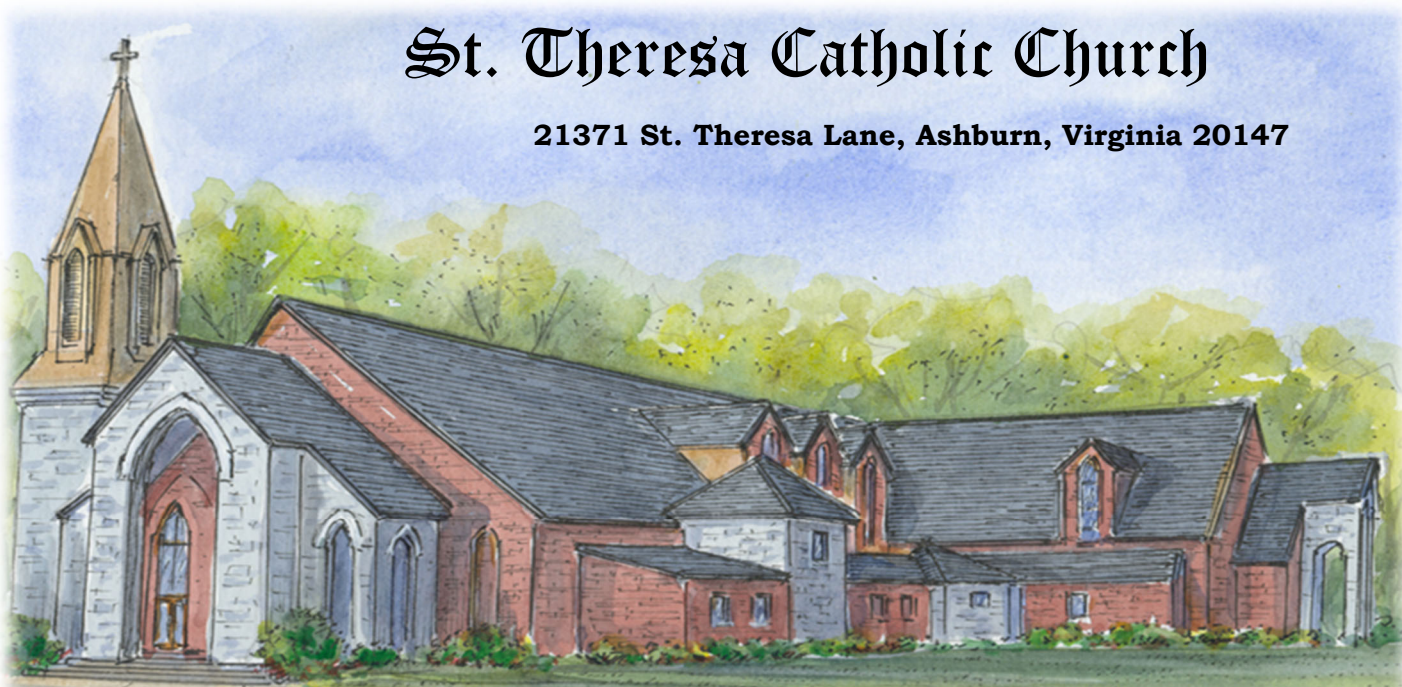

The 8th Commandment: You shall not bear false witness (part 3)

Let's finish the subject introduced two weeks ago and consider the morality of keeping secrets, including the priest's seal of confession. I could summarize this entire point by stating simply that, while we must keep certain things secret, we are still never free to lie. As the Catechism states,

...the right to the communication of the truth is not unconditional...The good and safety of others, respect for privacy, the duty to avoid scandal, and the common good are sufficient reasons for keeping silent or for discreet language. Everyone should show appropriate reserve concerning persons' private lives. (CCC 2488-9).

Remember once again the definition of a lie: "*speaking a falsehood with the intention of deceiving...*" (CCC 2482) Not everyone has the right to know everything, but we still can't lie to avoid spilling a secret. For example, it would be a lie to say, "I don't know anything about that," when in fact you do. It would also be a lie to make up false answers to intrusive questions.

How should we respond to an intrusive question without lying? Perhaps we could say, "I'm not free to discuss this matter with you now." Or, "It's really not appropriate for me to comment on that." Or my personal favorite, "Why don't you ask him yourself?" Occasionally we may need to be more direct and say, "That's private, and I can't tell you!"

Another way to avoid a lie is to remember that there are some secrets we should never agree to keep in the first place. Can we promise secrecy when someone tells us they intend to hurt themselves, or to commit a crime? Of course not! It would be wrong to keep such a secret. Whenever someone asks us to "keep this secret, no matter what," please remember that there are many times when we simply can't.

There is one exception to this, however—the seal of confession. What's told in confession can't be revealed for any reason whatsoever: *The sacramental seal is inviolable; therefore, it is a crime for a confessor in any way to betray a penitent by word or in any other manner or for any reason.* (CCC 2490) Does this mean the priest keeps secret everything that he has been told, no matter what? The answer simply, is yes.

As Christ himself taught us, "I am the way, **and the truth**, and the life." (Jn 14:6) In loving the eighth commandment then, it is Christ himself whom we love. Since we strive to love Christ with all our hearts, let's strive to love the truth with all our hearts and never forget his promise, "the truth will set you free." (Jn 8:32)

Trust

Keys hold great significance for those who carry them. They represent the trust and authority of the owner when given to another person. We may give our house key to a trusted friend to take care of our matters while we are

away. We may give keys to someone responsible for maintaining or working in a particular building. Keys to vehicles are given to people who have proven themselves responsible drivers. The readings today focus on this kind of trust—the trust that conveys authority and responsibility. In the

first reading, the symbol is specifically that of a key; but the second reading and the Gospel also speak of trust and leadership as they refer to the earthly church that Jesus established.

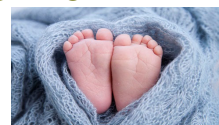

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

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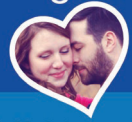

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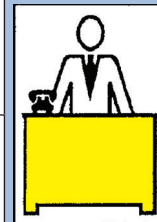
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
