Avoid road hazards
Watch for railroad tracks, storm drains, holes, oil, sand, gravel, and other hazard:

Use lights at night
Make yourself as visible as possible. Use a headlight and a tail light
Wear light colored cothing. Reflective leg bands are very effective.














