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Cafeteria Expectations

- Keep it clean! Clean up after yourself
- Walk at all times

<u>Optimism</u>

- Show a positive attitude
- Use appropriate conversations

Willingness

- Eat safely! Don't talk and eat at the same time
- Wait patiently to be called and remain seated

Empathy

- Use a peaceful/soft voice
- Use good manners: Raise your hand if you need something

- Listen to the directions of all the adults
- Respect others belongings and personal space



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Hallway/Staircase Expectations

- "Flush and wash and be on your way"


Willingness

Willingness

- Put equipment away in their appropriate places
- Alert nearest adult of unusual activity or behavior

Empathy

- Be a good sport
- Be friendly to others and include them in your activity

- Listen to directions given by all adults
- Get on line in an orderly manner
- Use equipment properly



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<u>Consequences</u>

Step 1- Friendly Reminder

Step 2- Conversation

Step 3- Verbal Warning



Step 4- MIR-Write up a Minor Incident Report and follow up with an action (consequence). At this step parents must be notified.

Step 5- If student displays disruptive behavior 3 or more times in one month, an office referral may be issued.

*Before an office referral is issued, parent contact must be made.
