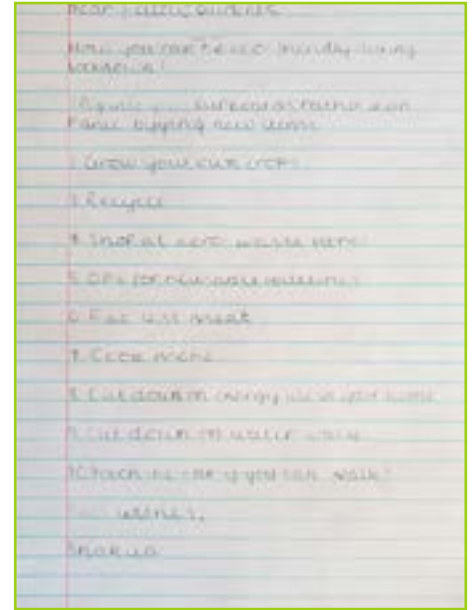

Keeping up the good work

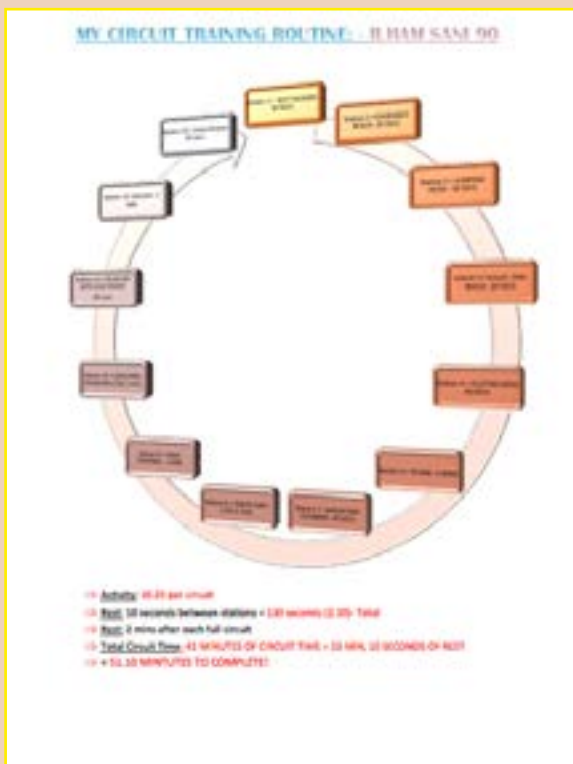

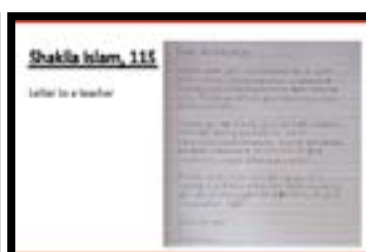
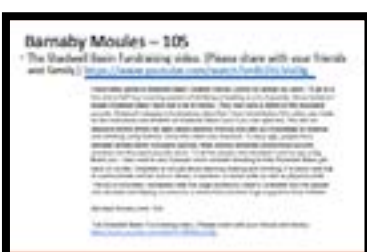
A special mention goes to Lila, Ijaz and Rebecca, from Ms Harmer, for the high standard of work they have produced and for their consistent engagement with Art.
