

The Southern Ohio Forest Rally is the fourth race of the Rally America National Championship.

Rally in Southern Ohio has a rich history, which included 17 events from 1973 to 1996. 2017 was the first year back and did not disappoint by being one of the largest rallies in the United States.

SPECTATOR INFORMATION

The Rally in the Southern Ohio Forest can be a dangerous activity. For everyone's safety, it is important to observe the following:

- NO ALCOHOL
- NO FIRES
- DO NOT cross barricades or banner tape
- DO NOT stand on the outside of corners
- DO NOT get closer than 100 feet to stage roads
- Cars will arrive at approximately one-minute intervals and there could be 5-10 minutes between vehicles. Stage is "HOT" until Sweep Vehicles have passed (Sweep Vehicles have yellow flashing lights)
- A stage is open to traffic only after green light vehicles pass through the stage
- **DO NOT USE DRONES** Drone use is not allowed at Rally America, Inc. sanctioned events without direct approval by Rally America, Inc. in advance.
- Please leave area cleaner than you found it

For Saturday please watch for the TOSRV bicycle race when in and around Chillicothe and the Ross Co fairgrounds.

PARKING RULES

Spectators are required to only park on one side of the road. We must leave one side of the road open at all times so ambulances, fire trucks, and police can respond in an emergency. Please obey the no parking signs so we have a safe event. Find an SOFR Volunteer for help.

Parking can fill up, arrive early. **Do not to park on the highways.** To ease exit you will be asked to park facing the exit of the road.






MAP FOR SATURDAY MAY 19, 2018

- Or Turn Left for additional parking


For Spectator Area 7/10

- Turn Right on to Pinev Creek
- Turn Left on to Park Road #1
- Turn Right on to South Ridge Road, Follow signs to spectator point

SATURDAY PARC EXPOSE


Crispie Creme Donuts will have a booth selling their famous donuts.
