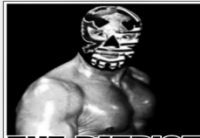

You may notice Security asking you to step into the office really quick to get your pass updated. This does not mean you owe money or that there is a problem, it's usually just that you have to go in and get your passes updated for the season. The office is working tirelessly to ensure passes are accurate. Please be patient as they update your passes. If you have season passholders that are not updated in our system, please be sure to do this as soon as possible. Security cannot allow persons to enter the park with outdated passes. We know that this can be a hassle sometimes, but it must be done to ensure we are not allowing the wrong people into the park.

Security has also been having issues with (some) members not presenting their passes. Please ensure you have your pass with you when entering and exiting the park. We understand that sometimes people forget, and that's fine, we can still manually punch you in, but there are some habitual abusers of that process. This drastically slows down the process of getting you into the park. We know that the scanners have been an issue lately, but rest assured that the board is on top of it and that they have it taken care of. Again, please be patient with security while we tackle this issue to better serve the members and please do your part by being prepared with your pass upon entering and exiting the park.
