


Using Cleanfeed with Zoom

There are two prerequisites for using Cleanfeed with Zoom.

- I. You must change your default browser to “Google Chrome”.
- II. You must use some sort of earphones, headphones, earbuds, etc.

I have generally found that the audio quality of Cleanfeed is better, sometimes a little, sometimes a lot. The idea is to make your Zoom connection as you normally would. Then in another window, open Cleanfeed and invite someone to connect (see below). Once connected, you would mute your Zoom microphone and use the Cleanfeed audio through your earphones. The process is not difficult but you do need to practice it a little. Here are the steps to establishing your FREE Cleanfeed account.

1. Search for “Cleanfeed” and go to the Cleanfeed website






5. Visit your email Inbox and look for a message from Cleanfeed. Check your Spam folder if it doesn't show up.



6. Open the email from Cleanfeed and click "Confirm My Email".



7. Click "Login Again".



8. Type in your Screen Name and Password, then click "Start".




9. You should land on the main page for Cleanfeed. Click on "Audio".



10. Click on the pull down menu and select "Music Optimised" (It's British...). Then click the "X" to return to the home screen.




11. Click "Connect".

12. Type in the name and email address of your student then click "Invite". Click "X" to return to the home screen.



13. Once your invite has accepted you will see your guest's name in the panel right below yours.

14. Click on the Settings gear then choose one of the options in the pull down menu. "Microphone Array (Realtek Audio)" works for me but you may need to experiment with your best setting.
