We will continue with the thorough cleaning schedule that we have in place at each school as well as ensuring that children regularly clean and sanitise their hands.

Thank you to all the parents that have sent their children back to school as it is vitally important that the children have the opportunity to continue with their learning. It is really important that parents continue to send their children into school unless there is a valid reason for them to stay at home.
