## SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN & YOUTH BILL

HOUSE 954

An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, dealing with child abuse: in criminal history record information, further providing for information in central repository or automated systems; and, in organization and responsibilities of Child Protective Service, further providing for services for prevention, investigation and treatment of child abuse. (Representative STEPHENS) - Children & Youth, April 20,2021

VOTE

This bill amends the Criminal History Record Information Act to provide for dissemination of information relating to child abuse investigations.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILLS

HOUSE 331

An Act authorizing certain financial institutions to conduct savings promotion programs. (Representatives R. BROWN, HILL-EVANS, OWLETT and others) – Commerce, April 20, 2021



This bill creates the freestanding Incentive Based Savings Program Act.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILLS

**HOUSE** 

747 1018 An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing for retail store operations during declaration of disaster emergency. (Representatives ROAE, KNOWLES, ECKER and others) - Commerce, April 20, 2021

VOTE

This bill amends Title 35 to permit retail store openings and curbside operations during an emergency declaration.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

HOUSE

**232** 

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) – Education, March 17, 2021

**OVER** 

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

HOUSE 359

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions, providing for exemption from taxation. (Representatives MARKOSEK, HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

HOUSE **385** 

35'

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

**HOUSE 430** 

An Act amending the act of May 25, 1945 (P.L.1050, No.394), known as the Local Tax Collection Law, further providing for effect of failure to receive tax notice. (Representatives EMRICK, GREINER, MILLARD and others) – Finance, April 7, 2021

C VOTE

This bill eliminates the Property Tax Penalty if property tax bill is not received during the first year of ownership.

## SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 71

47 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, providing for spending limitations on the Commonwealth. (Representatives WARNER, DAVANZO, DIAMOND and others) - State Government, March 22, 2021

OVER

This is a Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, providing for spending limitations on the Commonwealth.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE

**37**

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for learners' permits and for examination of applicant for driver's license; in rules of the road in general, further providing for prohibiting text-based communications, providing for prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices and imposing penalties; and, in operation of vehicles miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle and for the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle. (Representatives R. BROWN, MALAGARI, BOBACK and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021

OVER

This bill bans the use of handheld cellphones while driving.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE **150** 

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8391, on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman **2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge.** (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman 2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge.

**HOUSE** 

**151** 

An Act designating the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills 116 Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway. (Representatives SANCHEZ, BURNS, others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021 13

OVER

This bill designates the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.

**HOUSE 152** 

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, **KINSEY** others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021 **13** 

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.

**HOUSE 763** 

An Act amending the act of June 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, No.428), known as the State Highway Law, in construction, improvement, maintenance and repair of State highways, providing for native vegetation along highways. (Representatives B. MILLER, SANCHEZ, STAMBAUGH and others) - Transportation, April 19, 2021

OVER

This bill requires planting of native vegetation along state highways.

WARNER, SONNEY, **ROTHMAN** (Representatives others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021 This bill designates a bridge carrying State Route 2027 in North Union Township, Fayette County, as the SSG Willis J. Crayton Memorial Bridge. HOUSE An Act designating a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, 929 OVER Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout. (Representatives STAMBAUGH, BURNS, CONKLIN and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021 This bill designates a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout. **HOUSE** An Act designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 981 from OVER the intersection with Pennsylvania Route 819 to the intersection 1132 with State Route 2021 in Mount Pleasant Township, Westmoreland County, as the Honorable Mike Reese Memorial Highway. (Representatives WARNER, Ε. NELSON, others) - Transportation, April 19, 2021 2 This bill establishes the Honorable Mike Reese Memorial Highway. **SENATE** An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8556, 70 OVER carrying SR 1008 (Eckenrode Mill Road) over Chest Creek, located 228 in East Carroll Township, Cambria County, as the Kenneth John

This bill designates a bridge in Cambria County as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

SENATE 96

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for contributions to Veterans' Trust Fund. (Senators ROBINSON, MARTIN, BARTOLOTTA and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021

**OVER** 

This bill increases contribution amounts to the Veterans Trust Fund.

SENATE 120

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing for conditions of permits and security for damages. (Senator TOMLINSON) - Transportation, April 19, 2021

**OVER** 

This bill establishes requirements for the permitted movement of dozer blades.

### THIRD CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

SENATE 87

An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; in child protective services, providing for task force on child pornography; and, in sentencing, further providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of children. (Senators BAKER, ARNOLD, VOGEL and others) - Appropriations, March 22, 2021 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill amends Titles 18 and Title 42 to provide for enhanced sentencing of defendants convicted of child pornography if the child victim is under 10 years of age or prepubescent and further amends Title 23 to create the Task Force on Child Pornography.

### THIRD CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

**HOUSE 746** 

An Act limiting assignment of State-owned vehicles. ROAE, ROWE, THOMAS and others) - Appropriations, April 05, 2021 Fiscal-Note Attached 5

OVER

This bill establishes limitations on State-Owned vehicles used by Members of the General Assembly.
